EuroCourse is FIMCAP Europe's annual week-long residential activity at Easter. This year that activity is hosted by ZAK Malta. We will be with 65 young people from 11 countries living together, exploring the theme of solidarity.

In mixed teams the participants will create activities, games and program ideas for local groups in FIMCAP to use to promote solidarity. This will inevitably lead to each participant playing lots of new games, making new contacts and friends across Europe and experiencing different ways that youth organisations work.

We are looking for each organisation to send a team of 5 people as participants aged 18 - 25 years old who are open to sharing their organisational culture and learn from being exposed to others. They will need to be open minded and able to communicate in English. It is preferred if they are active leaders in a local group, as this would give them the common background with everyone else.

In solidarity with Umbrella Georgia, we offer their participants spaces on the same financial terms as all other participants, despite us not getting funding for them. To do this we will charge a participation fee of €50 to everyone. We would also like to encourage you to find the cheapest travel you are comfortable with as the money saved there will be put towards the travel of the Georgian participants.

Due to the type of funding being used, each organisation has space for a team of 5 participants, one of whom should be named as the group leader. If you only fill 4 spaces, they will not be funded. Therefore it is essential you fill your team spaces and send 5 participants.

If by the deadline of 16th February 2024 you are not able to fill 5 spaces, but have a smaller number interested, contact adric@fdf.dk and we can discuss what options are available to us. It is however unlikely we can take many participants without funding.
